Planting positive seeds is not enough, at Positive Expressions we want to create the best environment we can to help those seeds grow and flourish into what they were meant to be.

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Introduction

Positive Expressions is an alternative provision based in Hertfordshire. We have created a safe environment where our young people can come and learn, enjoy, and grow in a creative and innovative setting. Each site will have experienced, enhanced DBS-checked mentors to support our young people's development. Each 3-hour session will be a mix of online skills for life courses via AQA's Unt Award Scheme (UAS), class-based life and social skills, and in-person guest speakers to support getting work ready. Then our young people can develop on the site-specific programs we offer (music, health & fitness, and sport).

Our timetable is designed to help with transferable skills, so whichever choices our young people make in their futures, this will help.



Journey

I have supported young people in one way or another for the last 24 years and have loved every minute. I have worked with some of the most inspiring and uplifting young people who helped me to grow. Now is the time that I draw upon my considerable experiences and knowledge in this field to deliver something special for our most vulnerable and challenging groups. I have chosen to use sport, fitness and music as the mechanism and catalyst for change.
